

Village Of Manley
Board of Trustees Emergency Meeting
August 30, 2020

An Emergency Meeting of the Village of Manley Board of Trustees was called to order on August 30, 2020 on Main Street in Manley by Chairman Denise Swenson at 3:30 PM. Roll call was taken and members present were Denise Swenson, Mickey Dalton, Tim Glas, Rebecca Goble (via Zoom), and Adam Zierott, along with Village Clerk Jolene Dalton and Jack & Austin Lovell from Asphalt Specialists.

DSwenson & MDalton explained why this meeting was deemed an emergency. Asphalt Specialists have been in town doing the contracted street work this past week. As they were crack sealing Main Street, they felt that the street was in very bad shape and proposed an offer for the benefit of the Village. They proposed to chip seal Main Street (from where the concrete ends on the west to where the street ends going east) for \$7,500.00 since they had all their equipment in town already. A decision had to be made today because they would be finishing up with the Village work in the next day.

Jack Lovell from Asphalt Specialists addressed concerns of overspray and how long the street would have to be shut down. Overspray has been eliminated with the present day process. The chip sealing will go just to the edge of the present asphalt. The street will not need to be shut down. He also said the Village should get at least 5-6 years of use out of the chip seal.

This would actually be considered maintenance work on the street and would be a good trial of how chip sealing holds up & if it should be considered for the rest of the Village streets in coming years. After further discussion, MDalton moved & AZierott seconded that we have Asphalt Specialists chip seal Main Street this coming week for \$7,500.00. Roll call vote. All approved. Motion carried.

Adjournment TGlas moved & AZierott seconded to adjourn the meeting at 3:40 PM. Roll call vote: All approved. Motion carried.
